1. TOOLS AND MATERIALS REQUIRED

- STAR SCREW DRIVER
- ✤ ADJUSTABLE WRENCH
- WIRE CUTTERS
- WIRING SUPPLIES AS REQUIRED BY ELECTRICAL CODE

Attention:

Before assembling your lighting fixture, please read the following instructions. If you feel you do not have sufficient electrical experience, refer to a do-it-yourself wiring handbook or have your fixture installed by a qualified licensed electrician.

2. <u>GENERAL</u>

- 1. To ensure the success of the installation, be sure to read these instructions and review the diagrams thoroughly before beginning.
- All electrical connections must be in accordance with local codes, ordinances, or the National Electrical Code. If you are unfamiliar with methods of installing electrical wiring, secure the services of a qualified licensed electrician.
- These fixtures are intended for mounting to a standard 4" x 2 ¼" deep metal octagon outlet box. The box must be directly supported by the building structure and U.L Recognized.

4. Before commencing with the installation, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Turning the power off using the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.

NOTE:

The important safeguards and instructions appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood that common sense, caution and care, are factors that cannot be built into any product. The person(s) caring for and operating the fixture must supply these factors.

3. <u>UNPACKING THE FIXTURE</u>

On checking the contents of the box you will find:

- Back Plate
- Silicon Gasket
- Fixture Assembly (back and Front)
- 1 x G-9/120V Bulb
- Hardware Packet

4. <u>PREPARE THE FIXTURE</u>

Refer to figure I for illustration of fixture parts and assembly.

- 1. If you are replacing an existing fixture, disconnect and remove the old fixture. Expose the supply wiring from the outlet box.
- 2. Screw the supplied **Back Plate** to the junction box using the supplied **Screws (1)**.
- 3. Gently pull the supply wires through the center hole in the **Back Plate**. Slide the fixture wires through the hole in the **Back Portion** of the **Fixture Assembly**.
- 4. Ensure that the (waterproof) **Silicon Gasket** is fitted onto the designated area on the **Back Portion** of the **Fixture Assembly.**
- Connect the Black wire from the fixture to the Black supply wire and the White fixture wire to the White supply wire, fasten securely with supplied Wire Nuts (2) and secure Wire Nuts with UL listed electrical tape (not supplied).
- 6. Connect the Green Ground Wire from the fixture to the Electrical Supply Ground Wire, or attach the ground wire directly to the Ground Screw on the Crossbar. Fasten securely with supplied Wire Nuts (2) and secure wire nuts with UL listed electrical tape (not supplied). Tuck all wires carefully into the J-Box.
- 7. Attach the **Back Portion** of the **Fixture Assembly** to the **Back Plate** by aligning the designated holes on both the **Back Plate** and **Fixture Assembly**. Secure with the four supplied **Screws (3)**.
- 8. Insert the G-9 Bulb (4) (supplied).

DO NOT EXCEED THE WATTAGE AS PER THE WARNING LABEL.

- Fit the Front Portion of the Fixture Assembly over the Back Portion of the Fixture Assembly. Secure with the supplied Screws (5) by inserting the Screws (5) into the holes on the north and south ends of the Fixture Assembly.
- 10. Restore electricity and check the operation of your new lighting fixture.

CAUTION: IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Ensure that the (waterproof) Gasket is in place to prevent water leakage.
- Ensure that the Fitting is Cool and Switched off, Before Changing Bulb.
- Do Not use Bulbs Exceeding Maximum Wattage, As Per Caution Label.
- > Do not install this fixture in hazardous locations.
- Do not install fixture assembly closer than 6" from any curtain or similar combustible material.
