#### GENERAL INFORMATION

All electrical connections must be in accordance with all ordinances, Local and the U.S. National Electrical Codes (NEC). These fixtures are intended for mounting to a standard 4" metal octagon outlet box. The box must be directly supported by the building structure and U.L. recognized.

#### STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Before starting your installation disconnect the Power by turning off the Circuit Breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Just turning the light off at the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.

**During installation of this fixture please do not touch the LEDs or RF module. Touching may result in unwanted operation of the Lighting Fixture**

## MOUNT CROSSBAR AND MAKE WIRE CONNECTIONS

If there is an existing fixture remove it. Expose the supply wires from the J-Box. Secure the Crossbar Set to the junction box with the supplied Mounting Screws (1). Make sure that the Nipple already inserted into the Crossbar Set, faces outwards. Fit the Fixture Wires through the outer hole in the Metal Plate. Connect the BLACK supply wire to the Black wire of the fixture with supplied Wire Nuts (2) ensuring a secure connection. Connect the WHITE supply wire to the White wire from the fixture a secure with supplied Wire Nuts (2). Attach the ground (GREEN) wire from the fixture to the outlet box ground terminal (or to the box ground wire). Secure all wire nuts connections with UL listed electrical tape (Not Provided). Tuck wires carefully into Junction box.

## MOUNT THE CANOPY

Determine the best location for your fixture. Position the Floating Back Plate as desired, mark screw holes with a pencil and then drill holes. Place the supplied Screw Plugs (4-1) into the holes. Insert the Nipple through the Center Hole in the Metal plate. Now fit the Nipple through the closest hole available in the Floating Back Plate. Secure with the supplied Nut (3). Secure the Floating Back Plate to the wall with the supplied Screws (4-2). Slide the Flat Glass 1 (5) into the bottom of the fixture (allow to rest on metal shelf). Fit the Fixture Plate (6) over the Floating Back Plate ensuring that the 4 screws mounted to the Fixture Back Plate are placed through the designated holes in the Fixture Plate (6). Secure the Fixture Plate (6) to the Floating Back Plate with the supplied Brass Nuts (7).

## SECURE THE GLASS SHADE

Slide the Glass Diffuser (9) down between the Fixture Plate (6) side and back panels. Place the Flat Glass 2 (10) into the designated area on top of the fixture. Secure with the supplied Securing Metal Sheets (11) and Brass Nuts (12).

## RESTORE THE ELECTRICITY AND CHECK THE OPERATION OF YOUR NEW ACCESS LIGHTING FIXTURE

**CAUTION**

If this fixture is to be removed or replaced, please ensure that the electricity is switched off and that the fitting is cool before touching it.

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
