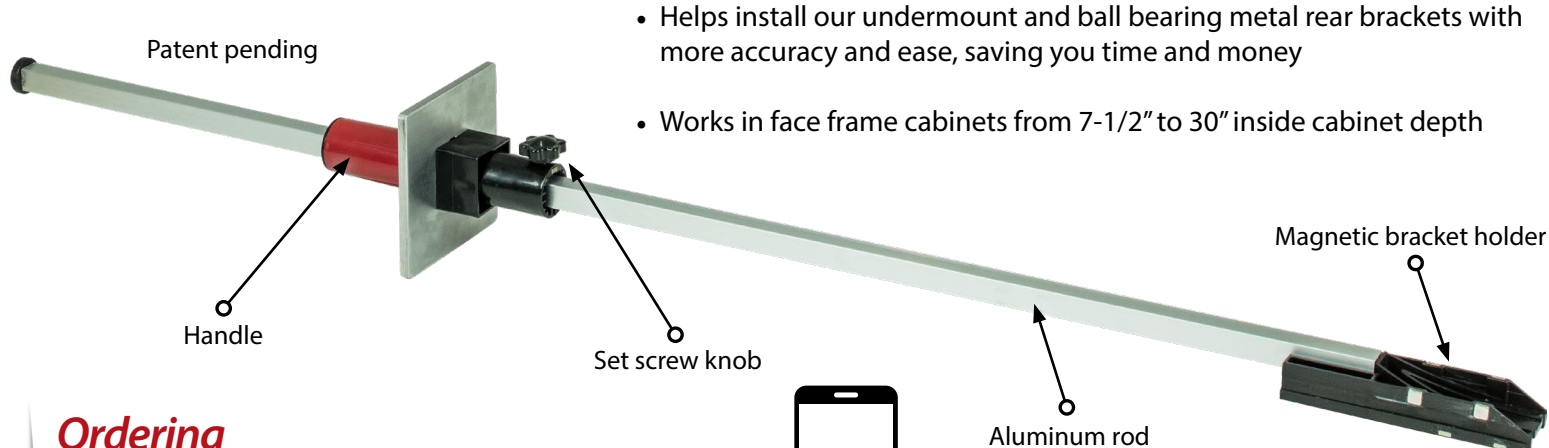

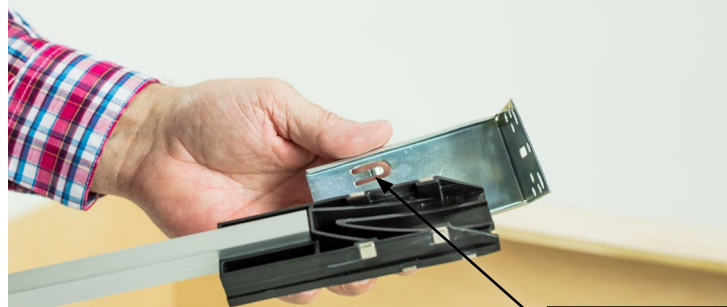

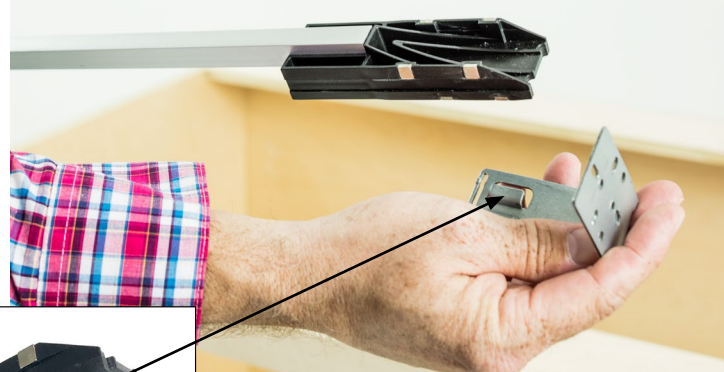
For Ball Bearing Slides



Insert ball bearing bracket tabs into the side channel of the bracket holder



For Undermount Slides



Insert undermount bracket tabs into the bottom channel of the bracket holder



With the set screw knob facing upward, place the bottom of the magnetic bracket holder into the bottom channel of slide bracket. Make sure the bracket is square and pushed firmly against end of bracket holder.

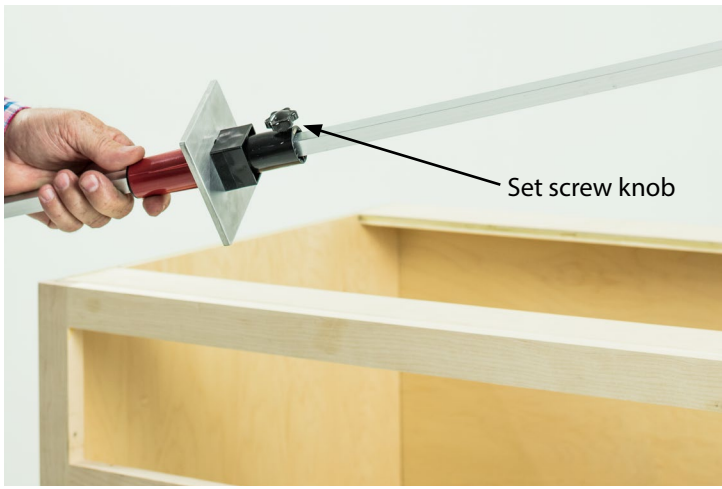


With the set screw knob facing upward, place the inside bottom of the slide bracket against the bottom of the magnetic bracket holder. Make sure the bracket is square and pushed firmly against end of magnetic bracket holder.

Step 2



Make sure set screw knob is facing upward. Loosen set screw.

Step 3



With your hand, grasp installation tool handle and place it in the bottom left corner of drawer opening. Be sure that the handle is flush and square against face frame.

Step 4



Making sure slide bracket is firmly attached to end of tool, carefully extend aluminum rod to back of cabinet with other hand.

Step 5



Keeping pressure on aluminum rod and bracket, tighten set screw knob for quicker installations of same cabinet depth.

Step 6



Attach slide bracket with screws using a drill or screwdriver.

Step 7



Slide out installation tool. Repeat process on right side.
