Pro Tip:

Take a photo of your existing wiring before you remove anything to make reconnection a breeze.

Safety First: Read Before You Begin

- Turn OFF power at the breaker before installation.
- Follow national and local electrical codes.
- Do not use with aluminum wire.
- Minimum wall box depth: 35mm.
- If your wall box has no neutral wire, call a licensed electrician.

Tips

- Wi-Fi is required for setup through the HunterSMART app.
- The panel also acts as a Matter controller, no hub needed.
- If your internet is down, you can still control devices locally over your Wi-Fi network.
- Updates happen automatically through the app.

Troubleshooting

- Panel not responding? Separate the touchscreen from the power supply, wait 10 seconds, and reattach to restart.
- Need to reset? Swipe down on the panel, select Settings > Devices & system > Restore factory.
- Weak Wi-Fi? Move your router closer or use Ethernet for stronger performance.
- Selling your home? Decommission the panel in the HunterSMART App.

Install in 5 Easy Steps

1 Remove Your Old Switch(es)

- Turn power OFF at the circuit breaker.
- Remove the switch plate and old switch(es).

2 Prepare the Wiring

- Uncap the wire connectors and gently pull wires forward. Take note of which wires are Live (L), Neutral (N), and Ground (G).
- Straighten wire ends and strip 10mm of insulation if needed.

3 Connect the HunterSMART Wall Panel

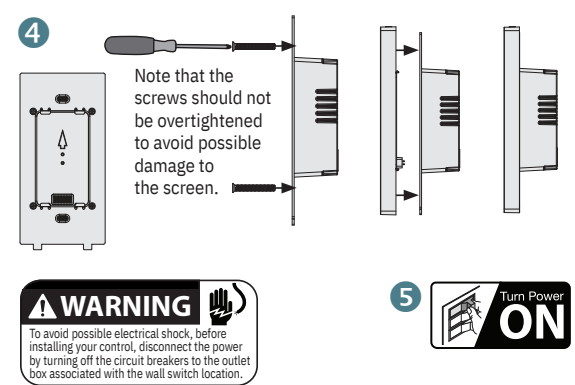
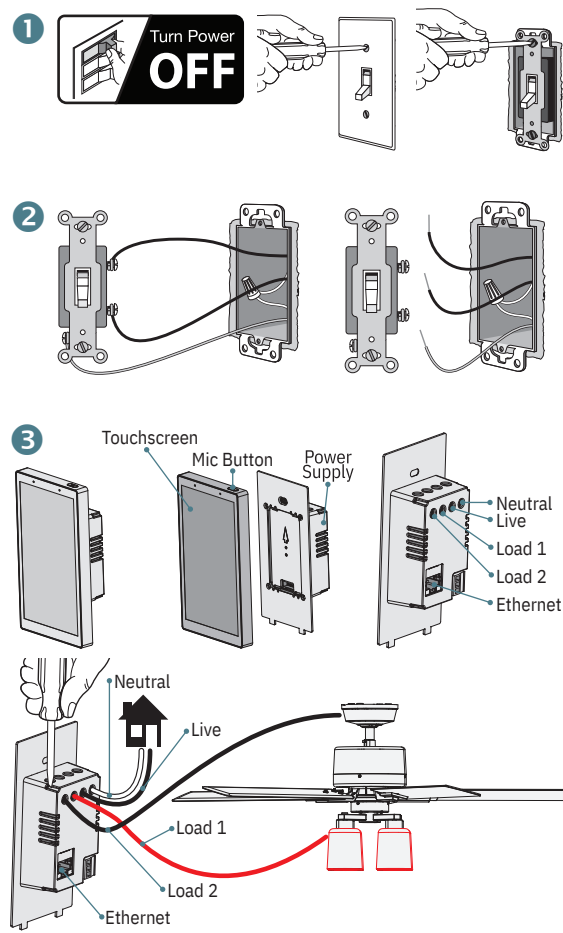
- Separate the power supply from the touchscreen by pulling apart.
- Connect Live (L) to house Live wire.
- Connect Neutral (N) to house Neutral wire.
- Optional: Connect Load 1 and/or Load 2 if controlling wired devices.
- Optional: Connect ethernet cable.
- Tighten all terminals with a screwdriver.

4 Secure the Panel

- Align arrow on the power supply upward toward ceiling and use included screws to secure firmly.
- Snap the wall panel touchscreen into place evenly across the face.

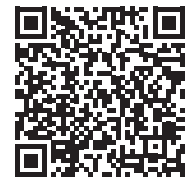
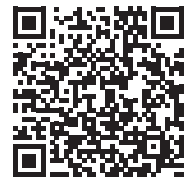
5 Power Up

- Restore power at the circuit breaker.
- The panel will light up and begin initializing.
- Proceed to connect to HunterSMART.

- In the app, select add device, then follow the on-screen prompts in the app.
- When prompted, scan the QR code displayed on your panel to connect.
