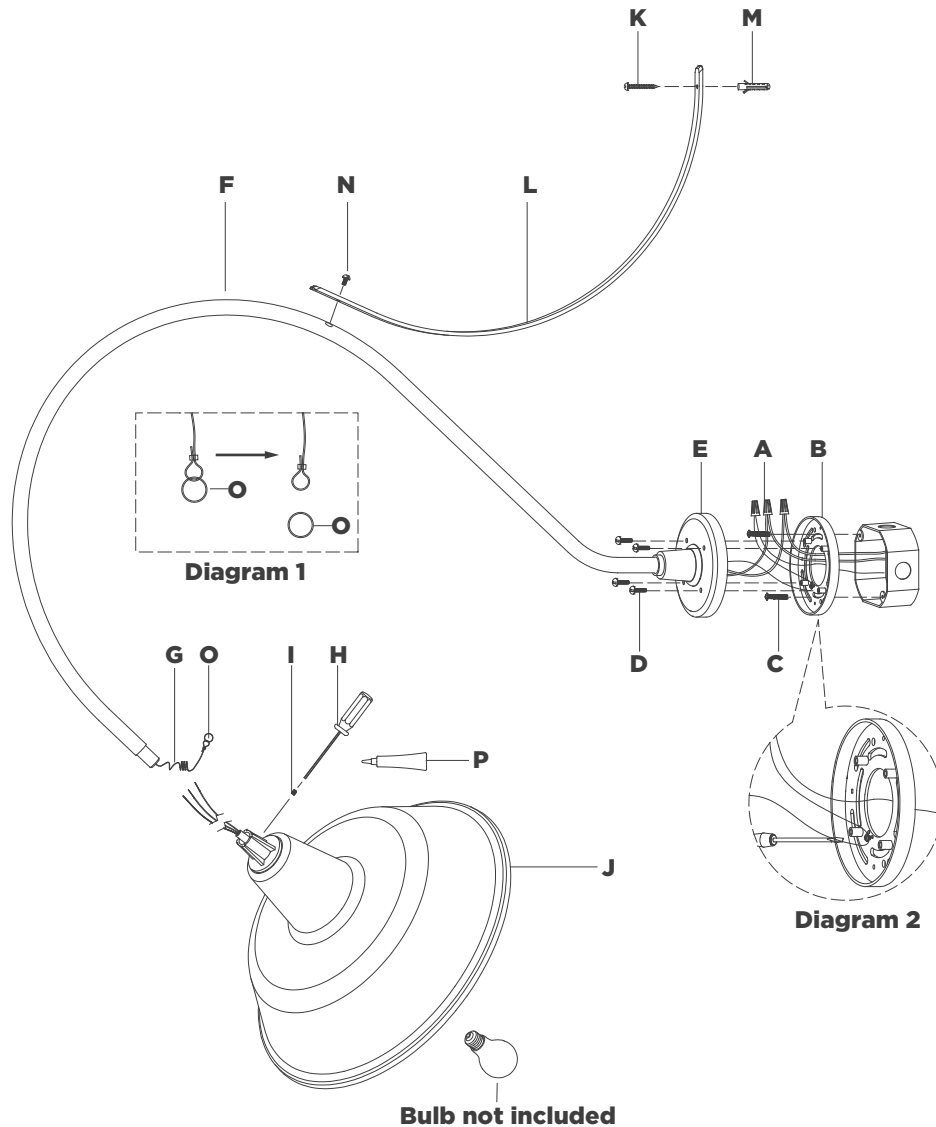


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



Academy 36" Anchored Larrabee Barn Light

Item # TOB2807

NOTICE:

This light fixture should be installed in accordance with all applicable, local installation codes, and by a person familiar with the construction and operation of it, as well as the hazards involved. Inspect item and contents carefully. If any damage or defect is found, do not install. Retain all packaging material until installation is complete and approved.

TOOLS REQUIRED (NOT INCLUDED):

Phillips Screwdriver	Slotted Screwdriver	Hammer
Pencil	Drill	

1. Carefully remove all parts from the box. Place on a clean, soft surface.
2. Remove mounting plate **(B)** from backplate **(E)** by removing screws **(D)**.
3. Install bracket **(L)** to fixture arm **(F)** and secure with screw **(N)**.
4. Using fixture arm **(F)** and bracket **(L)** as a guide, mark anchor position.
5. Using a drill bit slightly smaller than the anchor, drill hole in the marked position. Install anchor **(M)** into the hole using a hammer.
6. Install mounting plate **(B)** to the junction box and secure with mounting screws **(C)**.
7. Feed shade wires through fixture arm **(F)** until reaching backplate **(E)** using provided pull cable **(G)**.

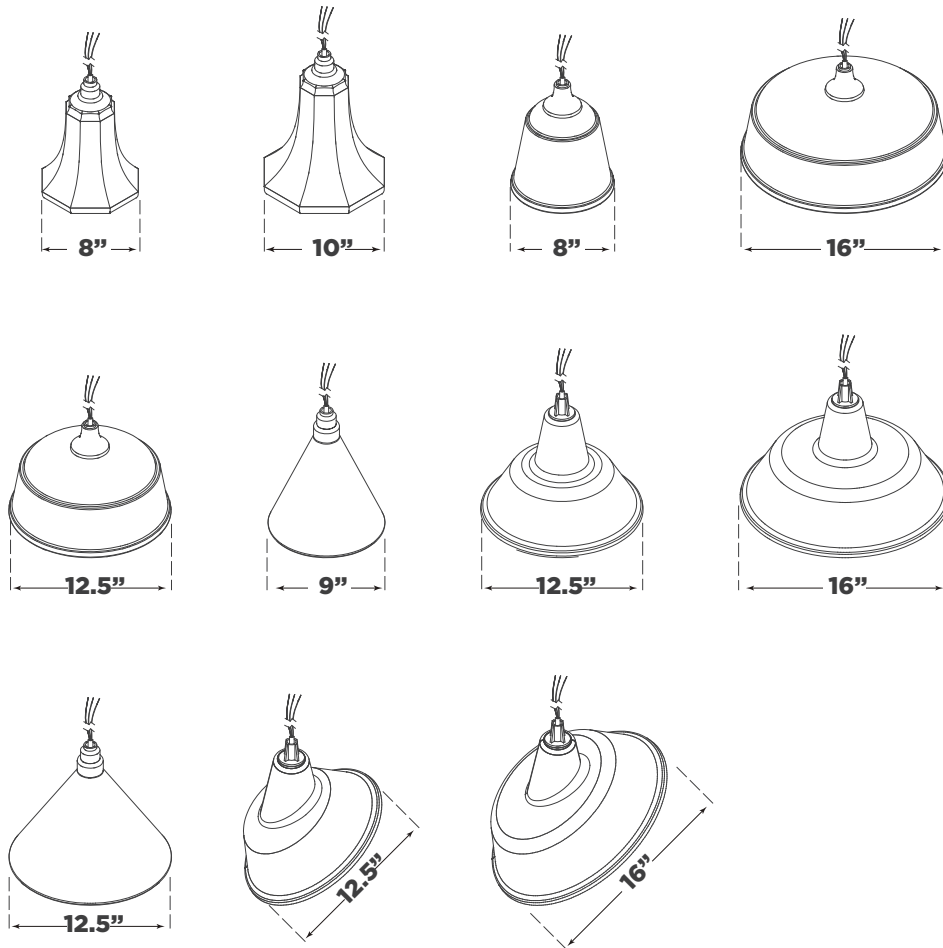
NOTE: Remove ring **(O)** from pull cable before threading (see diagram 1).

8. Apply the provided threaded-locking adhesive **(P)** to set screws **(I)**, then install shade **(J)** to fixture arm **(F)** and secure with set screw **(I)** using provided screwdriver **(H)**.
9. Wrap fixture ground wire (bare copper) around the green grounding screw (see diagram 2). Tighten. Continue fixture ground wire and connect to supply ground wire (usually green or bare copper) using wire nut **(A)**.

NOTE: It is imperative that the fixture is grounded.

Shade Option

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10. Connect fixture neutral wire (white) to the supply neutral wire (usually white) using wire nut **(A)**.
11. Connect fixture hot wire (black) to the supply hot wire (usually black) using wire nut **(A)**.
CAUTION: Do not reverse the hot and neutral connections.
12. Make sure all wire connections are tight, then carefully tuck into the junction box.
13. Install backplate **(E)** to mounting plate **(B)** and secure with screws **(D)**.
14. Install bracket **(L)** to anchor **(M)** and secure with wood screw **(K)**.
15. Install light bulb into the socket.

FOR OUTDOOR/WET LOCATION INSTALLATION:

16. Using silicone compound, apply a small bead where backplate meets the wall to prevent water from entering.
NOTE: Large gaps will need to be corrected before applying silicone compound.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: Clean only with a soft dry cloth or feather duster. Do not use abrasive or chemical agents.
